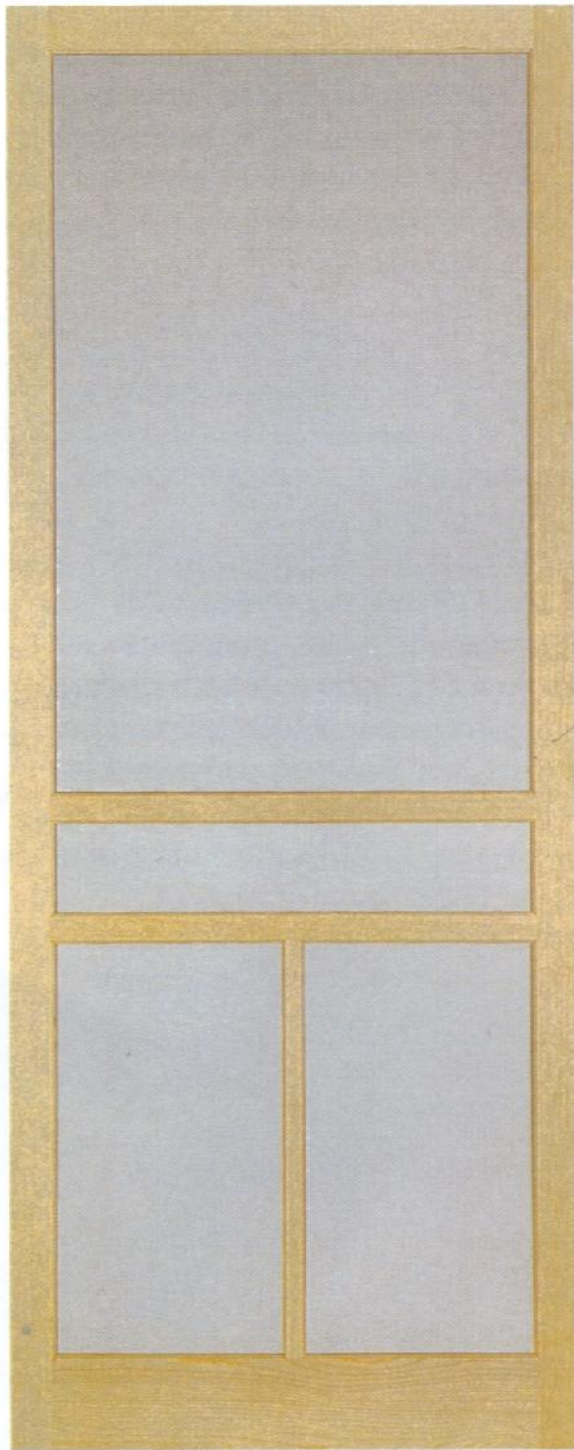
Quality shutters (or blinds) are also available, in both a louver and panel design. Our use of heavy blind stiles reduces the chance of warpage and provides more material at the assembly joints. A better production type blind has not been found!

Our bifold door line—louver, louver-over-panel, and full panel—offers features not available through many door manufactures. For example, we feel that adequate stile size is necessary for durability, as pivots and hinges must be attached to solid structural members. Our 1-3/4" stile provides a substantial area for the pivot attachment and decreases drill penetration into doweled joints. The result is a stronger and more lasting door unit.

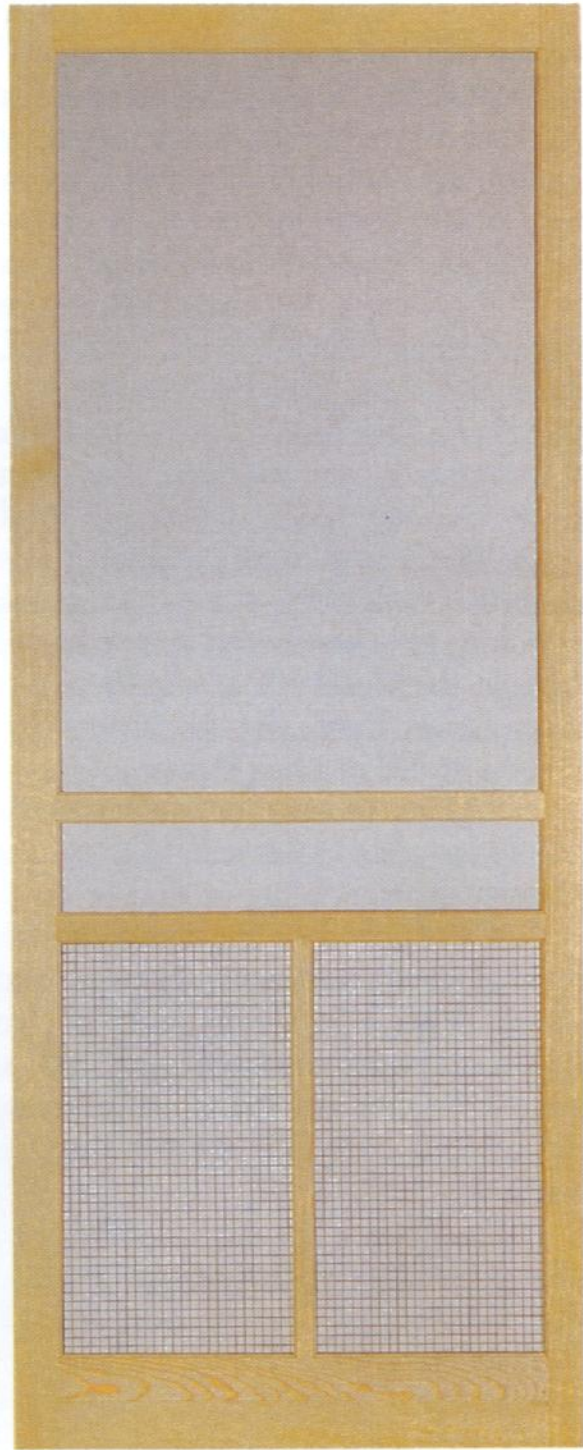

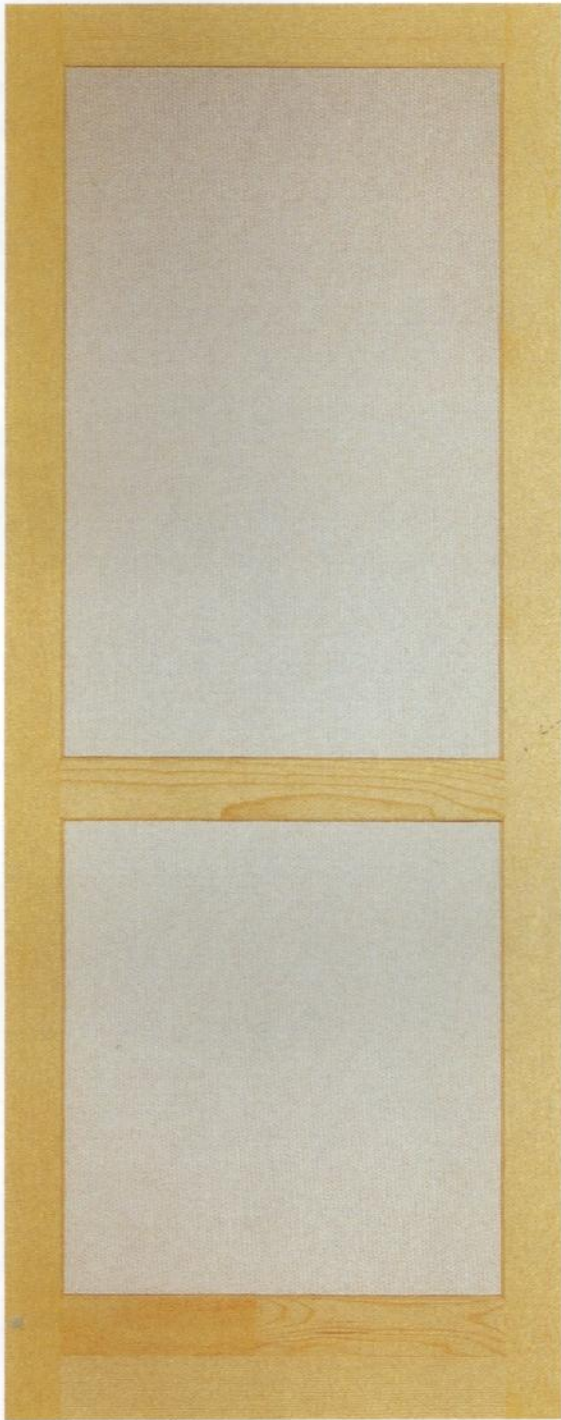

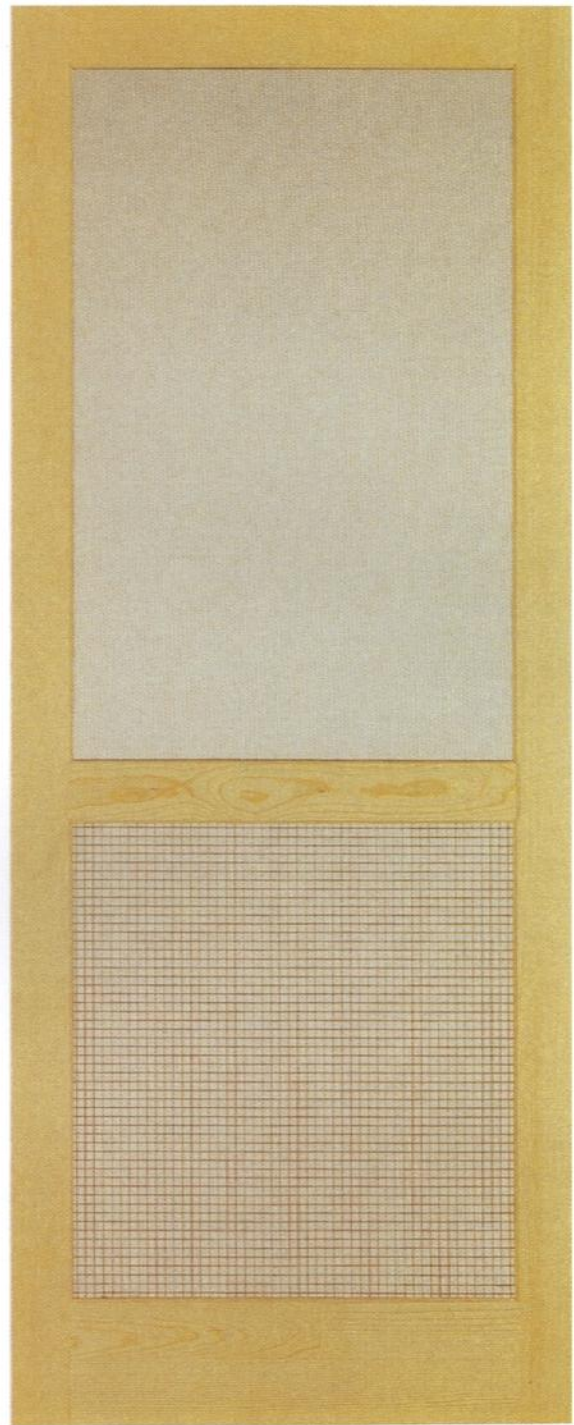
